

Dog Packing List

- A dog leash and an extra collar.
- An ID tag with your cell number and/or a number and the address at your destination.
- Your dog's medical records in case you need to see a vet while traveling. Also, pack a health certificate if it's required by your airline or hotel.
- Any required pet medications and/or supplements.
- Food – Pack enough food for your entire trip. Include a measuring cup or can opener if needed.
- Water – Pack two gallons of extra drinking water from home if your pet is sensitive. When you're down to the your last gallon, mix it with water from your destination so your dog gets acclimated to it.
- Food and water bowls, and also a portable water bowl for when you're out and about. Include a vinyl placement if you have the extra packing space.
- Treats!
- Your dog's favorite play and chew toys.
- Your pet's bed or a cozy blanket upon which your dog can sleep.
- A pet first aid kit.
- Waste removal bags.
- A sheet or blanket to place over the furniture and bedding at your destination.
- Your dog's carrier or crate.
- An approved dog restraint device if you're traveling by car.
- Grooming supplies such as brush or comb, and dog shampoo if needed
- A lint/hair removal brush or tape, for your clothing, your car and the furniture at your destination.
- Cleaning products including moist towelettes, paper towels or baby wipes, and also old towels, disinfectant and carpet cleaner.
